Upcoming Two-Year Walk around United States Celebrates Strong Families Nationwide, Worldwide

Houston, TX – January 14, 2010 – A newly formed, local coalition is set to make a worldwide impact beginning this weekend when Sapphire Jule King sets out on a twoyear journey around the United States. The journey will kick off at 6:30a.m., Friday, Jan. 15 at La Porte's Sylvan Beach Park Pavilion. Supporters, volunteers, and the general public are encouraged to attend.
